

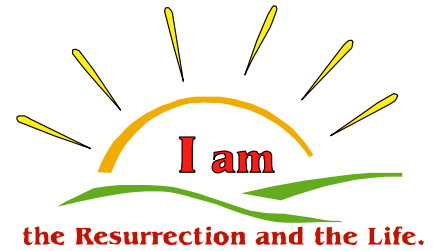
ALL SOULS. Today we commemorate all the faithful departed.

ADVENT

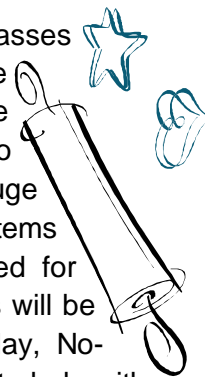
