FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT

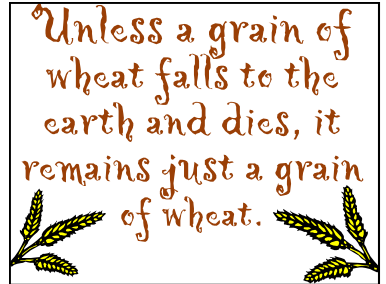
Readings for today's Mass are on page 241 of your Sunday missal.
