The Readings for Today's Mass begin on Page 428.

The Mass today celebrates in a special way what lies at its very heart, the body and blood of Christ, offered as sacrifice and given to us as food. By this sacrament we hope to become more godly, and also more truly human.

Exodus 24:3-8 Moses puts God's commandments into writing and offers sacrifices. With the blood of the sacrifices he seals the covenant on behalf of the people.

Hebrews 9:11-15 Christ is the high priest of the new covenant, sacrificing not animals but his own body, and sealing the covenant with his own blood.

Mark 14:12-16,22-26 During the feast of the Passover, Jesus blesses bread, gives it to his disciples and tells them to take and eat it as his body. He then blesses wine and tells his disciples to drink it as his blood, the blood of the new covenant between the Lord and his people.

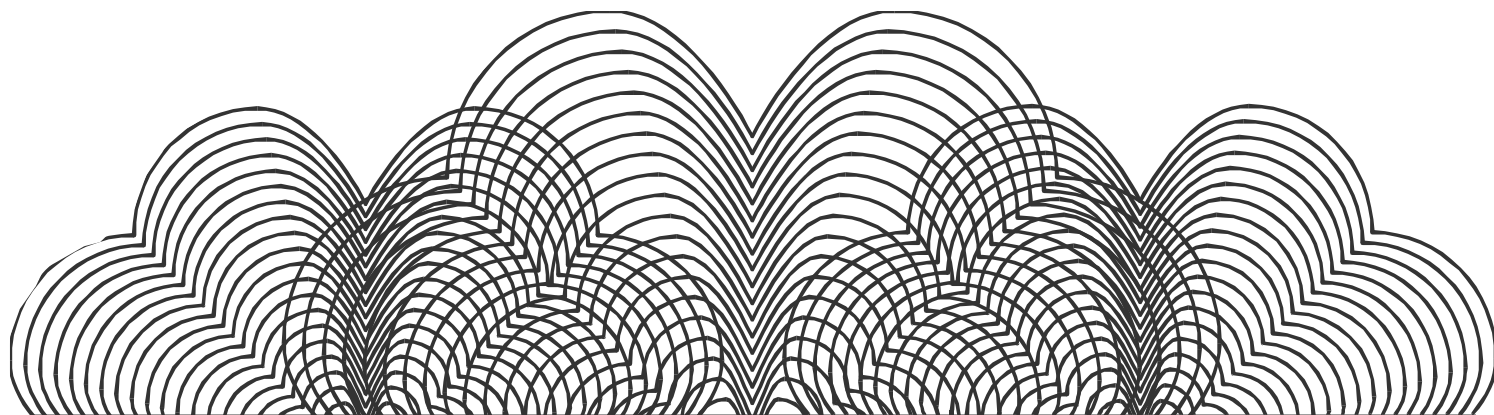

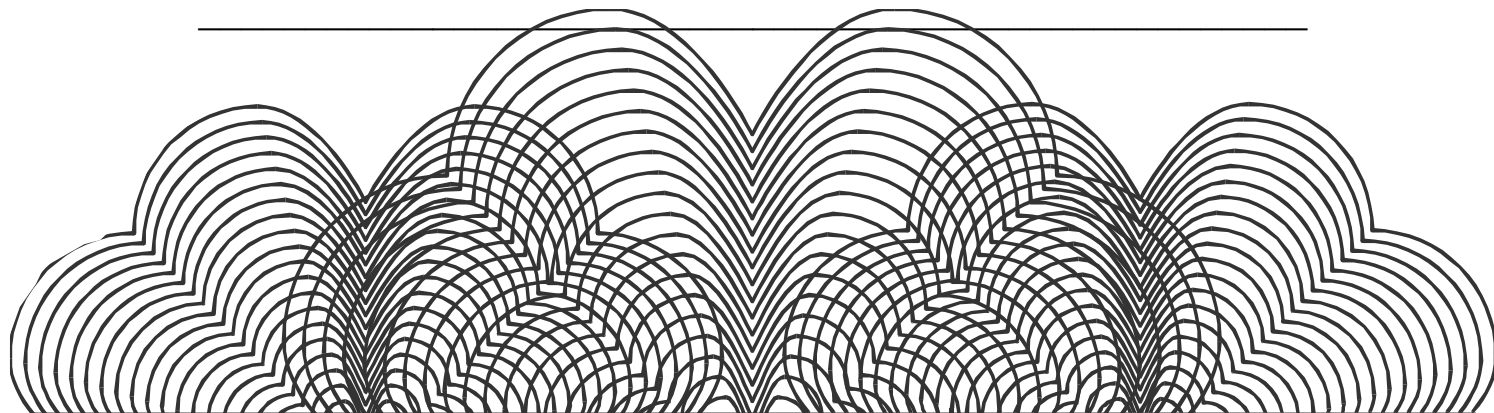
