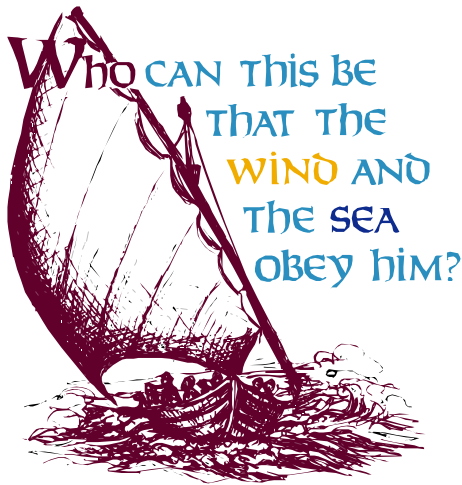

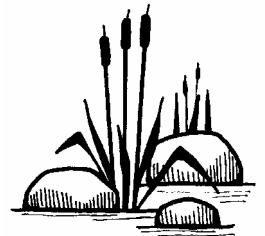

Women of Faith / Women of Action Conference

EWTN's Dr. Marcellino D'Ambrosio of EWTN fame will be the guest speaker at the 1st annual "Women of Faith, Women of Action" Conference and Workshop on **Saturday, Aug. 22** at St. Mark the Evangelist Catholic Church in Norman, Ok. Dr. D'Ambrosio will speak on spirituality both in a morning and afternoon general session at the conference, which is open to all Catholic women, as well as men. The aim of the first annual conference is to empower women in spirituality, service and leadership. The event will open at 7:45 a.m. and include additional speakers, a priest panel, vendors, and Pastoral Center services. Registration is \$30. A catered box lunch will be provided for an additional \$10. In addition to D'Ambrosio other "Women of Faith, Women of Action" speakers include: Maria Scaperlanda, author of numerous books about Mother Mary; Father Juan Molina of the National Catholic Relief Services Office; and Eunice Washa V.P. of the National Council of Catholic Women. In addition, attendees will have their choice of three breakout sessions in the afternoon on "Spirituality," "Service" and "Leadership." St. Mark Rev. Tom Boyer, national seminar speaker, will head the "Spirituality" workshop, discussing the Arts interpretation of death and the Resurrection. National speakers Fr. Juan Molina (CRS) will lead the Service workshop and Eunice Washa (NCCW) will present the Leadership workshop. A priest panel will entertain questions from attendees and include the Revs. Tom Boyer, Jim Goin and Paul Gallatin. Rev. Phil Seeton of Oklahoma City will lead the Byzantine morning and closing prayer and music services. The event will conclude with a Mass to begin at 5:30 pm at St. Mark.
